

Oxford Town Board Meeting

January 10, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Sandy Hagan. Roll call was taken with Sandy, Mike, Harlan, Peggy and acting recorder Pat Davis present. The minutes from the last meeting were read. The board made a correction that the meeting of the Anderson Park is on January 17 @ 7:00 P.M. at the town hall. Mike approved them and Sandy seconded them. Peggy gave the treasurer's report with an itemized list of all the bills paid. Sandy made a motion to accept and Harlan seconded it.

ROADS

Rick Keller had plowed the roads and put a sand/rock mix at the end of the roads for traction. Mike noted that if residents know of any trees downed or falling, they should contact a board member.

OLD BUSINESS

1. The IAJFB Update:

a. There was a fire at Scarlett Lavallo's barn on Nebula Street on 12-22-2016. Two ponies were lost. The call in was on a cell phone and responders had no address. One resident noted that emergency ID signs will help.

2. Contract Services

The township has a limit on the amount of money to be spent on contract services.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Local Board of Review dates have been received and posted for 2017.

2. Oxford was sent proposed amendments to the MN rules for Quality Standards for water protection.

3. Oxford received a Save the Date card for a drainage/wetland conference on 2/13/2017 in St. Cloud.

4. Anderson Park has the town hall reserved on 1-17-2017 at 7 P.M. for an open house regarding proposed development for Anderson Park.

5. The state auditor sent a statement concerning bodies giving gifts to other entities. It is assumed these gifts will benefit the township. There needs to be a resolution made by the town board with a two thirds majority vote to approve the giving of these type of gifts.

6. Joe Palawa noted that all the paper work has been distributed to all necessary bodies concerning the road improvement of Typo Creek Drive. In mid February, the projects presented will be ranked as to importance and hopefully funds will be allotted by the state.

7. Sheriff Chris Caulk was called to inspect a large amount of trash dumped in Oxford Township. He noted he could not contact any of the people whose names were found in the trash.

8. Oxford township will review books at the next town board meeting. The board decided to move the meeting to the 3rd Tuesday of February. That date will be February 21, 2017.

Harlan made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Sandy seconded the motion.
