

Oxford Town board Meeting
February 11, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Sandy Hagan. Roll call was taken with Sandy, Mike, Harlan, Peggy and acting clerk Pat Davis present. Pat Davis gave the minutes of the last meeting. As an addition to the minutes, the fire district would like an email requesting minutes of the fire meeting to be sent to the town supervisors. Mike approved the minutes and Harlan seconded them. Peggy gave a list of itemized bills paid and a monthly report of funds. Mike wanted a new highlight area at the bottom of the financial report for construction money to be used for Typo Creek Drive. Mike then approved the report and Harland seconded it.

ROADS

- A. Rick Keller noted all road have been plowed but compacted
- B. James Waters was present and made the following summary of Typo Creek Drive:
 - 1. There was a preconstruction meeting in November
 - 2. The site was cleared in December with a uniform layer of sand put in place
 - 3. Picometers were set in place before the sand was laid in. Measurements were taken on these but there has not been much change
 - 4. There was no further digging in the settlement area before sand was installed to prevent digging into an area of muck which would hamper settlement.

Mike noted that no additional bills on the project could be received until the April meeting.

- C. Ms Bixby was present at the meeting. She is going to build a house on Baylor in a housing addition. She went to the county zoning office and was told she should have two driveways because of pine trees falling. Mike was concerned about additional driveways on the town road. Later in the meeting, Trina from the Isanti Co. Zoning emailed that she was concerned about fire trucks getting in if trees have come down. Mike told Ms Bixby that there will be an extra charge for the second driveway when blacktop comes in. Mike make a motion to grant two drive ways to Ms. Bixby. Sandy approved the motion.

NEW BUSINESS

- A. County Commissioner Susan Morris was at the meeting to present a plan for a new veterans park in Cambridge next to the old court house. \$40,000.00 has been raised but an additional \$200,000 is needed. People can purchase a spot in the park for a veteran by buying a brick to be placed in a wall. The brick will have the name of the veteran engraved on it. Susan left some literature that she would like shown at the annual meeting.
- B. Susan said the county has been trying to get more money from the state for broadband, road repair and home placement of children taken out of their homes.
- C. The town board did additional work on the 2020 budget, life insurance statement and employee payment form.
- D. There is a list of 2019 permit for building in Oxford Township

- E. Sandy had a test report of Oxford's new well that showed arsenic level well under state guidelines. The report showed what should be done to drop these levels even lower.
- F. A Bus driver had complained about the condition of the road that goes through a development on the old Hesse Farm. This is not a township road and is not taken care of by the township. The people on the road have been told if they bring the road up to town road standard, the town will look at taking over the road

Mike made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Harlan seconded it. The meeting was adjourned.
