Regular Meeting Minutes
April 14, 2020

The Zoom virtual meeting was called to order by Sandy Hagan. Roll call was taken with Sandy, Mike, Peggy, and Linnea present. Minutes of the last meeting were read with Mike approving them, and Sandy Hagan seconding them. Peggy gave a treasurer's report with an itemized list of bills paid. Mike made a motion to accept, and Sandy Hagan seconded it.

Roads

Typo Creek Drive update – James Watters from MSA was on the meeting call and gave an update on progress. There have been calls from concerned residents about the weight of the trucks hauling fill, and if residents ask, there will not be more fill hauled until the end of June.

Rick Keller was on the call, and said that it has been too cold for grading, but hopefully they will get out next week.

Sandy was out and picked up garbage off Type Creek Drive last week, and 259th has a bunch of garbage that needs to be picked up. James mentioned that there has been some vandalism to equipment that Dressl left at the Typo Creek Drive work site. Linnea will contact the sheriff to ask for extra patrol when they need to leave equipment in the future.

Old Business

Fire District update-Vicki Nielson gave an update and said that this week's meeting will be held in the garage, and they are not offering virtual meetings at this point. Currently, they are only being sent on emergency calls as they are short on PPE (personal protective equipment).

Sandy gave an update on township emergency identification signs. They plan to install when it warms up. Also, we need to change out street signs to meet the new reflectivity standards.

New Business

Peggy has new checks that allow for a single signature, and has asked for the board to authorize single signature checks to pay Oxford bills during the Stay Home period for COVID 19. Mike Miller made a motion to allow the single signature as long as the bills to be paid are approved at the regular meeting. Sandy Hagan seconded the motion. Linnea will send an excerpt of the minutes that document this change in procedure as well as the list of approved bills to our bank.

MAT Spring short courses have been cancelled. Mike has a Zoom meeting for the MAT tomorrow, and will learn more about meeting recommendations during the COVID stay home order.

Mike Miller made a motion to adjourn and Sandy Hagan seconded the motion.
