TOWNSHIP OF OXFORD

WARNING!!! IT'S AGAINST THE LAW TO PLOW SNOW ACROSS THE ROAD.

Minnesota State Statute 160.2715

The action of plowing snow onto and across public roads is a violation of Minnesota law and City ordinances and is punishable as a misdemeanor under Minnesota Statute 160.2715. Subd. 1. Misdemeanors are punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000 and/or jail sentence of up to 90 days. The person responsible for depositing snow on or across the road may also be liable in a civil lawsuit if damages or injuries occur as a result of the action. If this activity continues in the future, it may be necessary for the City to take legal action. This could result in significant costs, which may be assessed against you.
